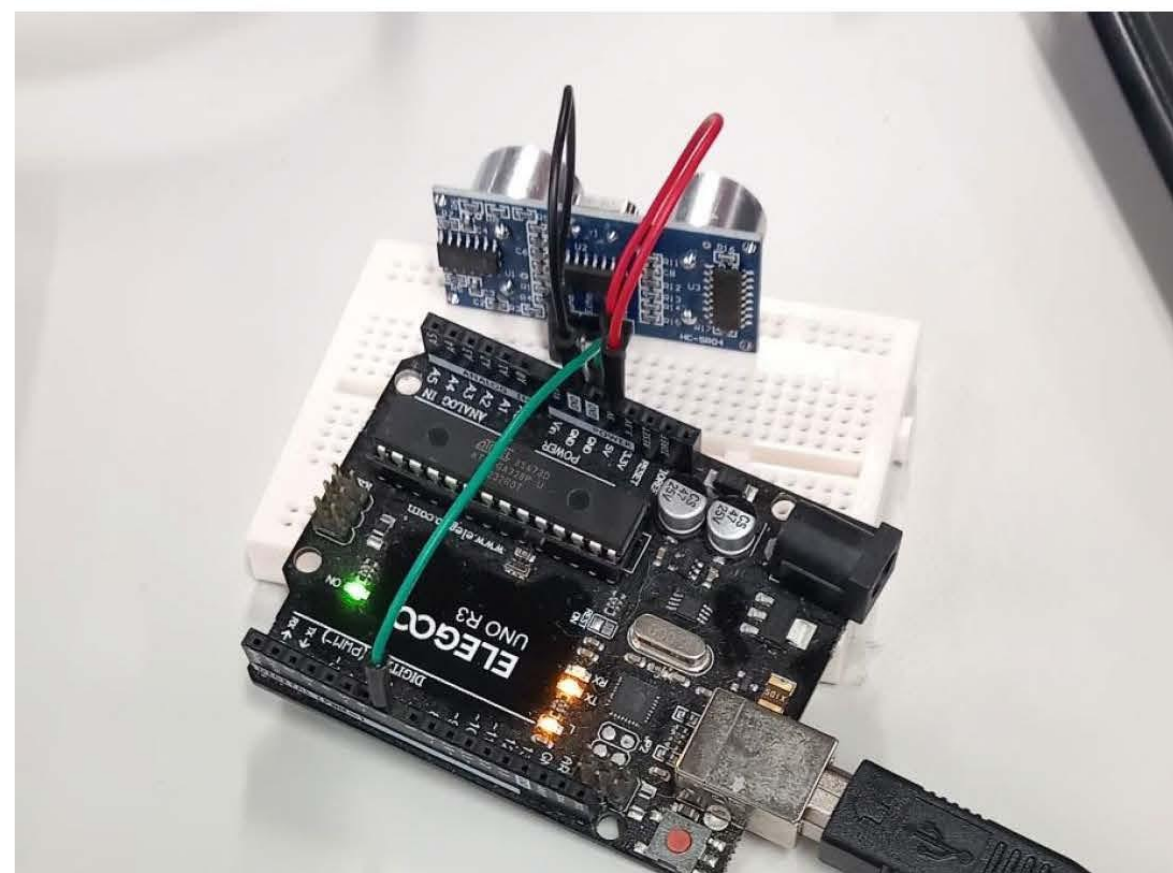
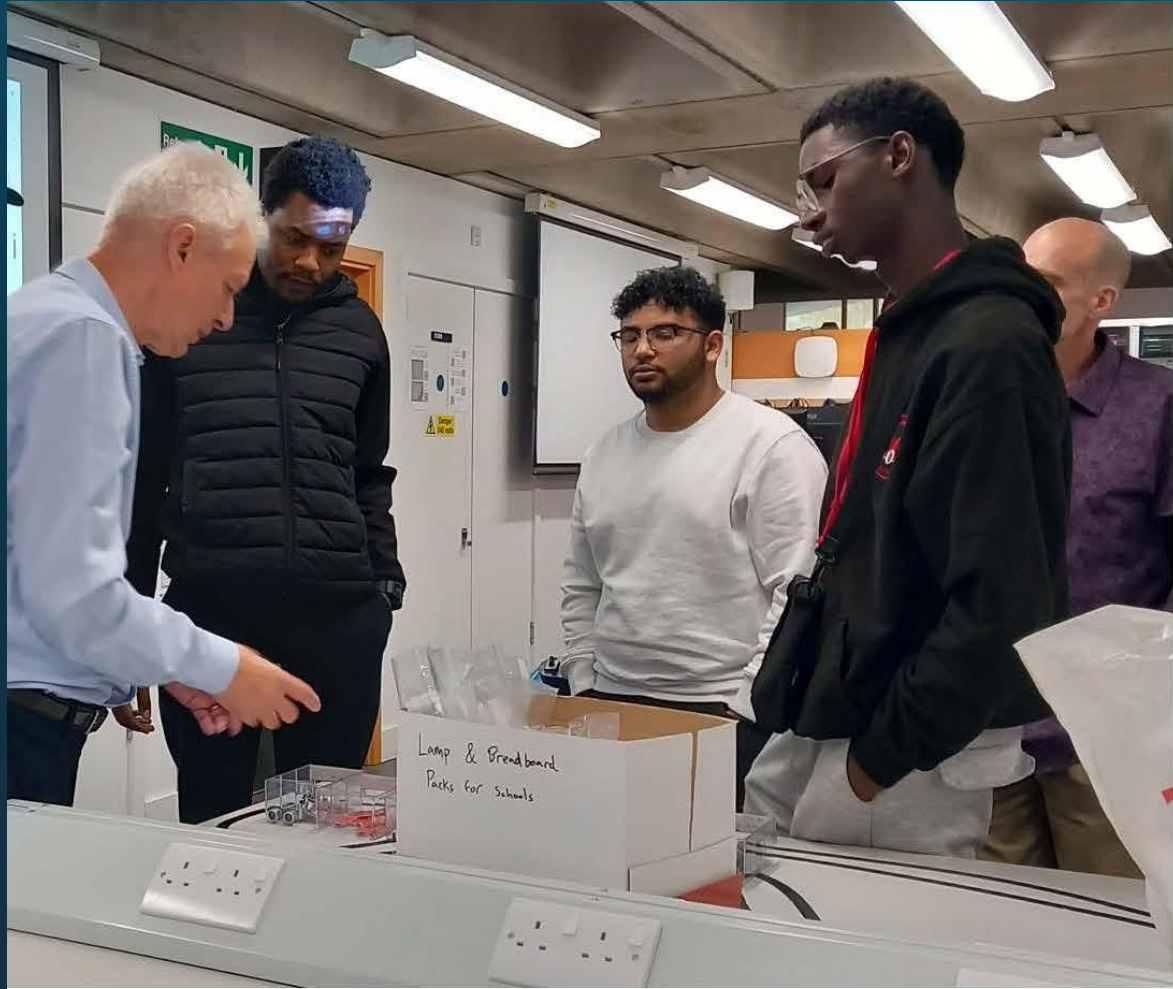
Discover adventurous activities like kayaking, canoeing, abseiling, and surfing at Seaburn and Roker's beautiful blue flag beaches.

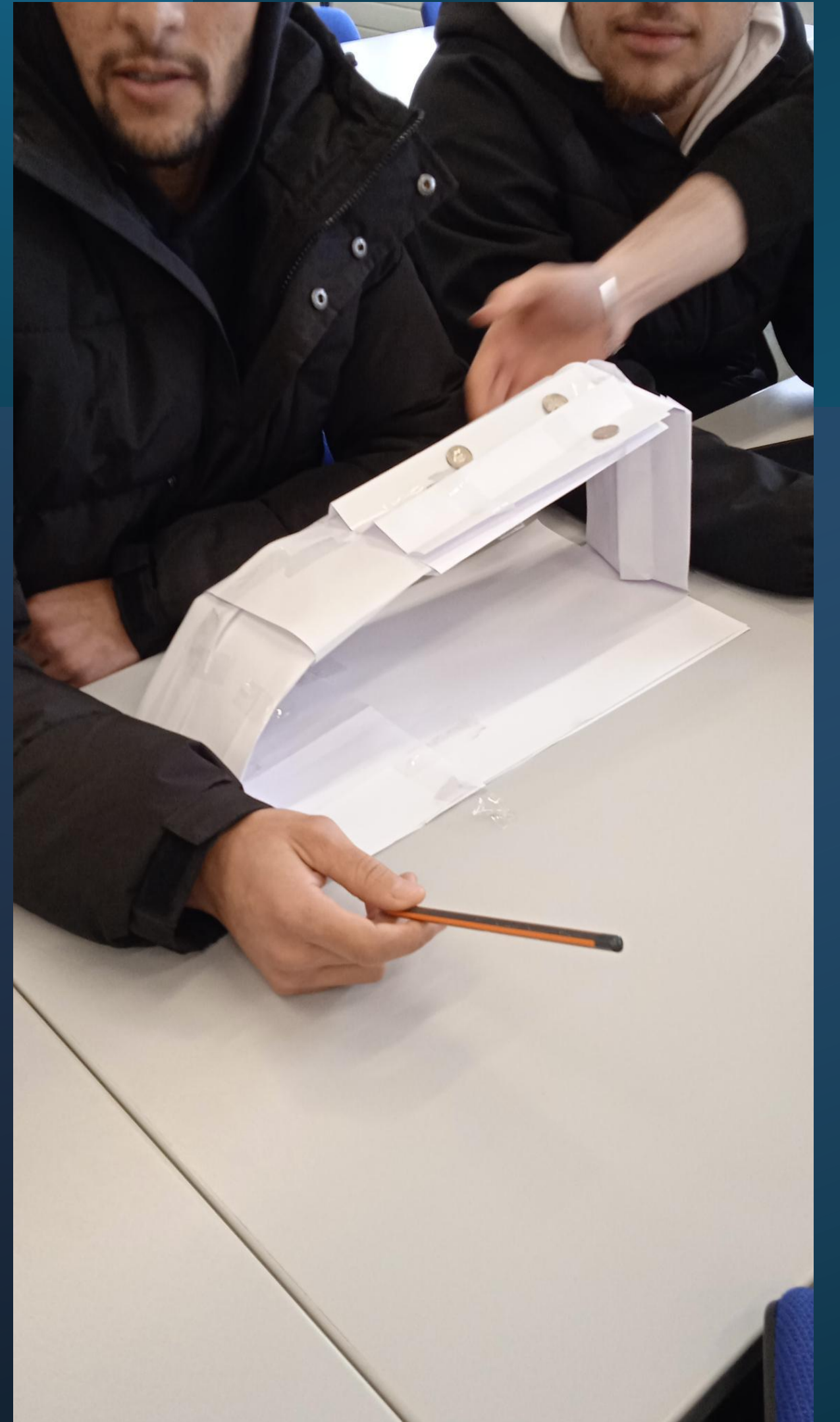

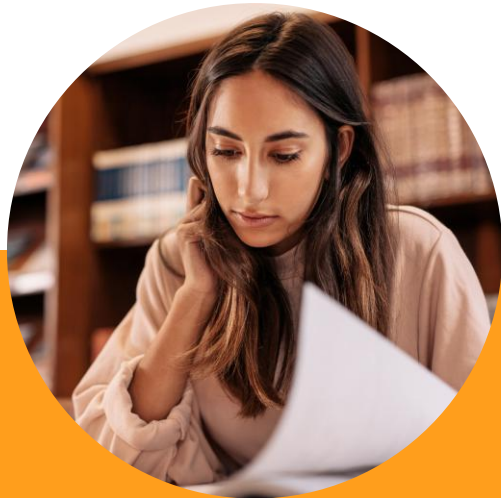
