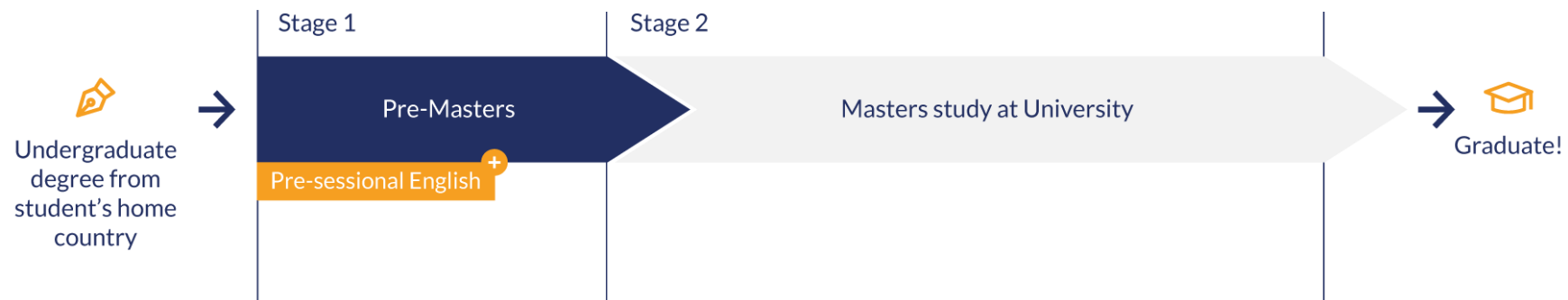

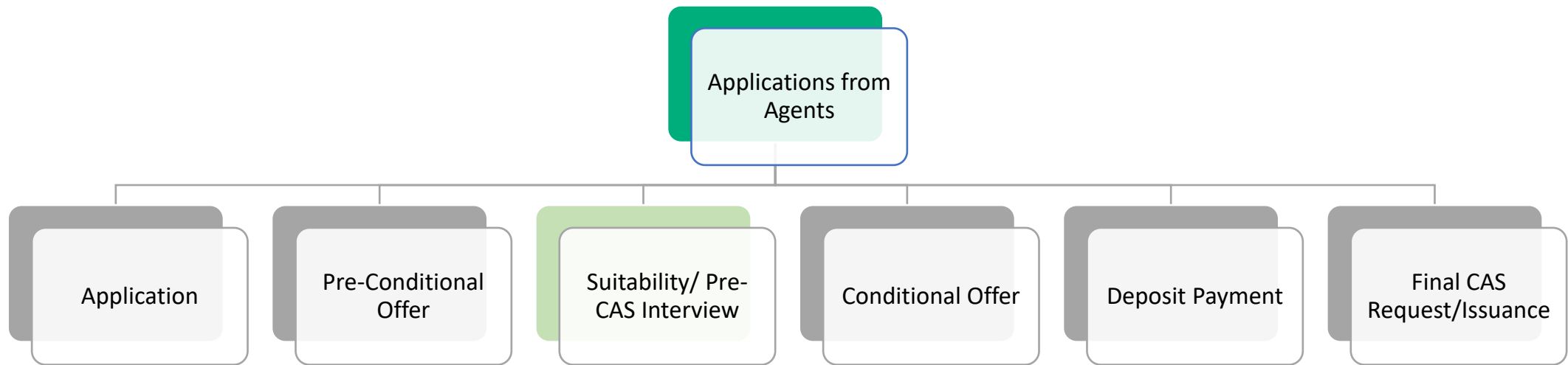

ACADEMIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Foundation entry- 12/20 in French Baccalaureate, IB Diploma Grade 18, 24-48 UCAS Points, Minimum of 5 C's in, WASSCE or NECO or GCSE or IGCSE (including English and Maths)
- ✓ First Year Entry- At least one year of post secondary education OR Ordinary National Diploma (OND) OR A-levels, IB Diploma Grade 22
- ✓ Pre-Masters Entry- Higher National Diploma (HND) OR Third Class Degree
- ✓ CCA Vocational Programme- High School Completion plus one year post graduation
- ✓ Study Gaps- UG- 3 to 5 years
PG- 7 to 10 years

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

- Integrated programme- Minimum of C grade in WASSCE
- Non-Integrated- IELTS 4.5 (Foundation)
- Non-Integrated- IELTS 5.5 (Pre-Masters)
- PTE, Language Cert, ELLT accepted

OIEG - English Language Level Test

The English Language Level Test (ELLT) is an alternative to IELTS that provides students with evidence of their English language level for entry into top UK universities or other educational institutions.

The ELLT is a four-step assessment which is 100% online, taking students one step further into higher education all from the comfort of their own home.



OIEG - ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEVEL TEST

Test construction:

Part 1 – Automated **reading** test (40 min)

Part 2 - Automated **listening** test (20 min)

Part 3 – **Writing** task (60 min) - submitted directly to the examiner via the portal

Part 4 – Live **speaking** test (20 min) with an OIETC examiner

The results:

The student will receive an official certificate and report within 3 days

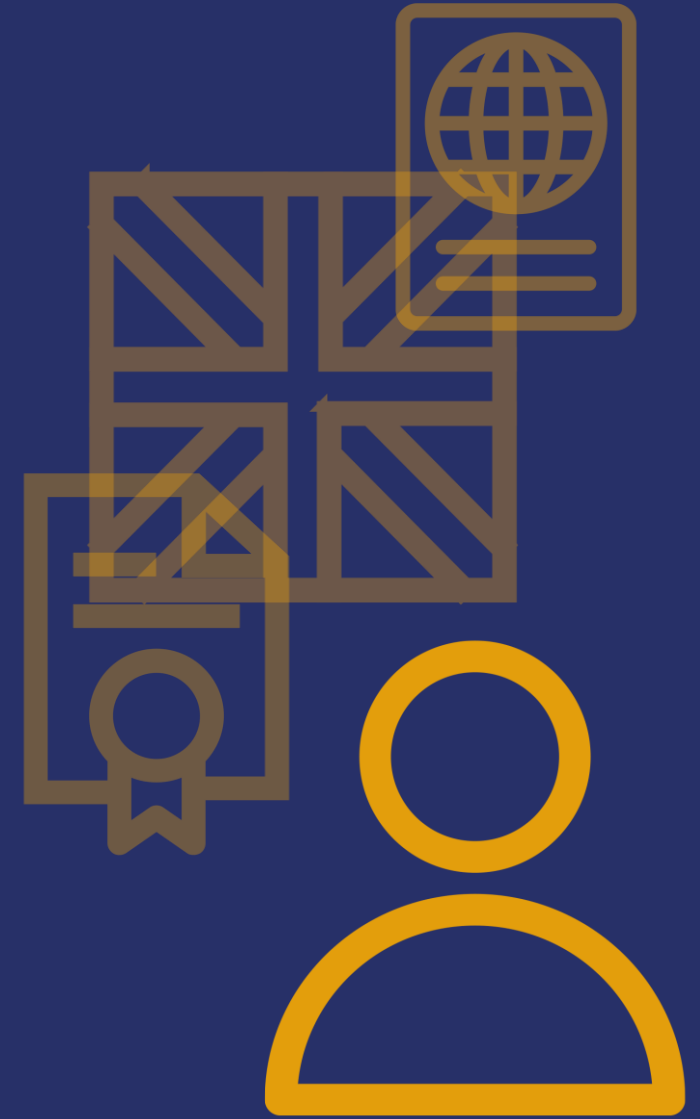

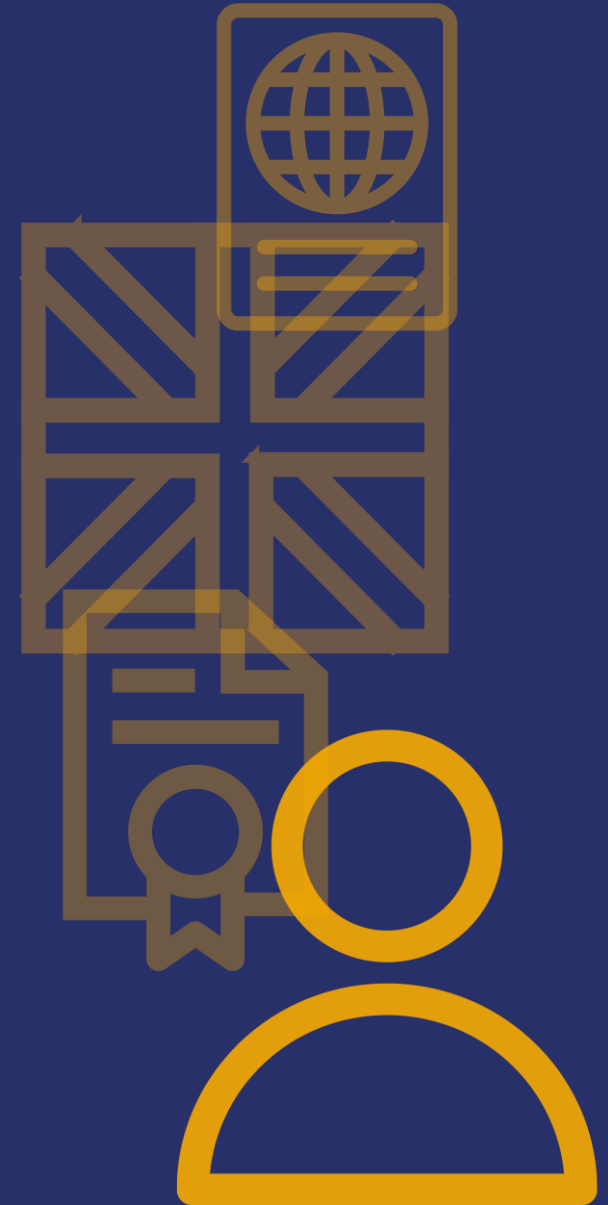
